Mollusks on the Move

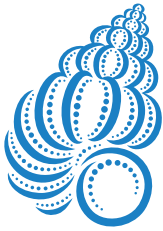
Museum educators travel to schools throughout Southwest Florida with an interactive experience of live mollusks, shells, games, and artmaking. Students are introduced to the amazing world of mollusks and their habitats. Students receive a shell ID guide and shell to keep.



Field Trips to the Museum

Students meet marine life in the aquariums, explore the Great Hall of Shells, take a guided tour with Museum educators, and participate in a scavenger hunt and other activities. Students receive a shell ID guide and shell to keep.
