
The Adopt-A-Class Giving Program sponsors exceptional education for K-12 youth about the amazing world of mollusks, their shells, marine life, and conservation.



MOLLUSKS ON THE MOVE

In this mobile program, marine biologists bring local mollusks to classrooms. Hands-on programs introduce many aspects of a mollusk's life including anatomy, growth, diet, reproduction, and their role in the ecosystem. These experiences include touching live mollusks and shell identification. Each student receives a shell identification guide and a shell to keep.





MOLLUSKS ONLINE

Marine biologists bring the Museum and wonders of shells and mollusks virtually to classrooms via Zoom and WebEx. Programs featuring the Giant Pacific Octopus and other animals introduce viewers to the diversity of molluscan life and their habitats, the basics of conservation, and highlights of the Museum's shell collection.
